

Since 2013, we have examined More than 320,000 people and over 22,000 eye surgeries have been performed



Primary Eye Care Sevices




Al Baseer is providing primary eye care services in different districts of Sindh province mainly include Ghaaro, Sujawal, Kunri and Thatta. People are screened for eye problems. Patients identified with cataracts and other eye problems are referred to Al Baseer Eye Hospital for examination and treatment

During the reporting period, a total of 5613 people screened in the Ghaaro district in which 597 people were referred to Al Baseer Eye Hospital.

In Sujawal, 7856 people were screened and 718 people were referred.

In Thatta, 250 people were screened and 11 people were referred. In Kunri district, 6119 people went through eye examinations and 144 cataract cases were found and operated on.



On 15th October 2021, Al Baseer Foundation organized the "Eye Health Exhibition" to celebrate World Sight Day with the International theme "Love Your Eyes" at Marriott Hotel Karachi, Pakistan.

The purpose was to create awareness on comprehensive eye care and influence the government to designate funds for eye health programs.

Key stakeholders and policymakers who were actively involved in the exhibition included the provincial government, International Non-Government Organization, eye institutes, the health department, the education sector, and Organizations for Persons with Disabilities.

Following are the main activities organized during the exhibition:

On World Sight Day 2021, Al Baseer Foundation took the initiative to create awareness on Comprehensive Eye Care by organizing Eye Health Exhibition. The young eye health professionals were encouraged to participate in the poster competition to raise awareness on the prevention of vision loss through their posters.



The judges of the poster competition included ophthalmologists, community ophthalmologists, senior optometrists, higher officials from the education and health department, representatives from the International Non-Governmental Organization and Organization for persons with disabilities.

STALL FOR DIGITAL AND ASSISSTIVE TECHNOLOGY IN EYE HEALTH

The role of digital technology in eye care is essential to make services available in the remotest areas. It helps in generating the data and insights, which can help identify where the need is greatest, and how to reduce the barriers to access for those who need it most.

In the exhibition, the Sindh Institute of Visual Sciences (SIOVS) presented Peek technology, a data capture tool integrated with smartphone apps that helps in vision screening and referring patients to the nearest health facility for eye care services.

STALL FOR ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY FOR BLIND OR LOW VISION PARTICIPANTS was organized to raise awareness of accessibility and rehabilitative services. Assistive devices included screen readers for blind individuals, screen magnifiers for low-vision computer users, video magnifiers, braille watches, and other devices for reading and writing with low vision.

STALL FOR CHILDREN WITH INTERESTING ACTIVITIES AND VISION SCREENING

In the stall for children, activities were organized to highlight the significance of eye testing and wearing eyeglasses. Al Baseer's team shared the researched facts regarding the potential effects of screen time on eyes with school-going children including the 20/20/20 rule.

EYE TESTING IN COMMUNITIES

Al Baseer team organized eye screening camps in the poorest communities on the occasion of World Sight Day 2021.

More than 450 people went through eye testing. Out of which, 329 received medicines for allergic conditions, 297 were provided with near-vision glasses, and 107 patients were referred to Al Baseer Eye Hospital for detailed examination and treatment.


